As of April 2010, Contractors, Builders and Property Management staff who disturb lead-based painted components within private residences, apartments, multi-family housing communities and child occupied facilities built prior to 1978 must have a Certified Lead Renovator onsite.

To become a Certified Lead Renovator, one must complete an eight hour EPA approved Lead Renovator Training Program. Participants who successfully complete the one day course shall be provided certification for a period of five years.
